Each stamp of this Colonial issue shows a different part of the journey. The Angolan issue shows their seaplane Santa Cruz near Fernando de Noronha. Designed by Cutileiro and printed Litho Litografia Nacional, Oporto.

Issues in ascending values: *Harpa doris*, *Murex melanamathos*, *Venus foliaceo lamellosa*, *Lathyrus filiosus*, *Cymbium cisium*, *Cassis tessellata*, *Cypaea stercoraria*, *Conus prometheus*, *Strombus latus*, *Tympanotonus fuscatus*, *Cardium costatum*, *Nautica fulminea*, *Lyropecten nodosus*, *Tonna galea*, *Donax rogosus*, *Cymatium trigonum*, *Olivancilaria acuminata*, *Semifusus morio*, *Clavatula lineata*, *Solarium granulatum*.
